Below are some of the ways you can volunteer in our garden community. Please check all that you are interested in, and return this form to one of your Board Members.

- Society Board Member – help with all of the “behind the scenes” work. Currently, we meet monthly, 3rd Saturday of the month, 1pm. Please speak to Barbara Sibbald, the Vice-Chair, if you are interested. Phone 250-474-1698.
- Market Volunteer Coordinator – this position involves making sure there are 2 people covering the Market stall at the Q Centre.
- Market Stall assistants – There are 4 market days left and we are in need of people to look after the stalls. Sunday, July 8 and 23, and August 5 and 19, 12 – 4pm at the Juan de Fuca Library Parking Lot. All proceeds go to the Colwood Community Garden.
- Maintenance team - All members are required to keep their plot and surrounding area free of debris and weeds, but sometimes a communal task needs assistance. As a member of this team you may be asked to do a number of things, such as help prepare the pathways, repair/maintain fences, gates, among other things that will come up.
- Fundraising and Event Coordination team – The Community Garden has some major expenses, such as water and insurance, which the rental fees will not completely cover. Other expenses will also come up, such as sheds and tools. We need a team that is willing to help with some of the following, or just to help brainstorm: donation letters and grants, assist with Market Stalls, create crafts to sell at the Christmas Craft Fair. Other events may be seed exchange, Little Gardening Library, start of season and/or end of season party, and the annual general meeting. Lots of opportunities! The more people the better!!
